

- Our facility at 935-941 Teche St. was the site of the famous Whit(n)ey's Ballroom in the 1930-40's.
- Algiers was then one of the leading centers of jazz music in the United States.
- Lovingly restored in 2022-2024, AMAS preserves and celebrates the rich history and culture of the Old Algiers neighborhood.
- Today, AMAS is the center of music and culture on the West Bank.

- AMAS held 56 community events in the last half of 2024; including music concerts, art exhibits, dance and music classes and school assemblies.
- The AMAS Community Center is rapidly becoming the center of the Old Algiers community.
- The AMAS Foundation was recently rewarded for its work in the community by the 2024 Greater New Orleans Foundation Grant.


